SUBJECT: Trash Services

For the past several years owners within the park have been provided services to remove excess trash items from their lots through the use of Don Miller's trailer. Don started this service as a way for people to clean up their lots and help beautify their lots which also beautifies the park. With the retirement of Don and Bona from management of the park, this service will no longer be available for several reasons:

- Too many abuses of this service have occurred with people trying to dispose of RV refrigerators, mattresses, batteries and other hazardous waste
- Without the use of a trailer, the association would have to purchase one for this purpose
- We would also need to make a fenced area to keep the trash and recycle items so that the park doesn't look so trashy when people drive in.
- This is not an expense the Board is willing to make at this time.

There is a landfill approximately 5 miles east of Montpelier on Highway 89. It is open Monday through Saturday from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. to accommodate your need to dispose of **ALL** of your trash to include brush, household appliances, lawn mowers, barbeque grills, gazebos, swing sets, trampolines, and hazardous waste, etc. The dumpsters are limited to routine household garbage during times when the park has a lot of people.

Our dumpsters are emptied on Friday and Monday. If on Thursday or Sunday evening there is room in the dumpsters, brush (AND ONLY BRUSH) can be placed in them.

If you have metal that you would like to recycle, Hennings Salvage at 802 Bern Road is open Monday-thru Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m.
